**Brief Description of Duties:**

Performs functional tests, analyzes performance and troubleshoots the electronic, hydraulic, pneumatic and mechanical functions of avionics systems and subsystems. Removes, repairs, calibrates, installs, aligns, harmonizes, boresights, inspects and conducts operational performance checkout of integrated avionics systems. Maintains historical data of avionics systems. Clear red X symbols on maintenance forms as authorized and performs avionics systems debriefings with aircrews. Provides hands-on training instruction to lower-graded personnel concerned with the repair of integrated avionics systems. Prepares for and participates in various types of readiness evaluations such as Operational Readiness Inspections (ORI). Inspector General (IG) Inspections, Unit Effectiveness Inspections (UEI), and mobility and command support exercises. Complies with safety, fire, security, and housekeeping regulations. Ensures that material and equipment are properly stored, protected and maintained. Maybe required to operate computer test stations and nonautomatic test equipment to determine scope of repair or adjustment required to correct faulty operation of avionics components. Performs other duties as assigned.

**Qualifications:** WG-12

**General Experience** Experience, education, or training which demonstrates a knowledge of electronics principles involved in number of applications such as radar, data processing, and data display, as well as mechanical and hydraulic knowledge involved in the operation of equipment such as control valves, gyros, turrets, and mounts and mechanical computing devices.
