Position: Aircraft Mechanic, WG-8852-10/12

Brief Description of Duties: Directs, monitors, or performs overall maintenance, servicing, and documentation for one or more aircraft. Works closely with Job Control to report current aircraft status and to request specialist support for accomplishing intermediate level maintenance beyond flightline capabilities or time constraints. Accomplishes operational tests of aircraft systems and components. Inspects and determines that aircraft are prepared and safe for flight. Prepares for and participates in various types of readiness evaluation such as ORI, IG and UE inspections, mobility, and command support exercises. Monitors and conducts on-the-job training for assigned personnel. Complies with safety, fire, security and housekeeping regulations. Insures that material and equipment are properly and safely, protected, and maintained. Performs other duties as assigned.
