**Position:** Aircraft Engine Mechanic, WG-8602-10, 80112000

**Brief Description of Duties:** Performs on or off equipment maintenance on propulsion systems. Determines extent of disassembly necessary to repair or replace engine parts. Analyzes inspection findings to determine extent of repairs, diagnoses repeat/recurring malfunctions, and recommends and performs necessary repairs. Modifies engines and components in accordance with time compliance technical order (TCTO) directives. Conducts tests of repaired components using jet/turbo/prop test cell and related test equipment. Performs engine trims and power runs on engines after Isochronal inspection on aircraft in accordance with applicable directives. Performs engine storage in accordance with applicable directives. Performs isochronal and special inspections on engines. Interprets inspection findings and determines adequacy of corrective action. Performs fixed and mobile test stand functions, installs special test equipment; and performs pre-operational and post-operational checks. Selects, operates, maintains, and interprets resultant data from various types of test equipment. Prepares man-hour collection via Core Automated Maintenance System (CAMS) and other required forms. Provides assistance in other aircraft maintenance functions such as ground handling, marshalling, towing, serving, and inspection of aircraft. Assists in requisitioning bench stock, materials, parts and equipment. Requisitions, processes, and accounts for supply assets as required by the repairable processing system. Complies with safety, fire, security, and housekeeping regulations and ensures that material and equipment are properly stored, protected, maintained and secured. Performs other duties as assigned.

**Qualifications:** WG-10

**General Experience:** Experience, education, or training which demonstrates the applicant's knowledge of aircraft engine parts and components and an understanding of general mechanical systems; knowledge of and skill in the use of the proper type and size of tools to perform assigned work.

**Specialized Experience:**
